

Agrément Certification for Roof Cassettes

WHAT IS IT?

The BBA Agrément Certificate is recognised standard of quality within the Construction Industry. It is a UKAS-accredited product and system certification scheme which enables manufacturers to demonstrate a product's fitness for purpose and compliance to the latest building regulations. Agrément certification provides an independent and impartial assessment of a product or system.



WHY IS IT REQUIRED?

New technical guidance has been specified by warranty providers for roof cassettes being used in residential schemes. The new standards come into effect from January 2024, with manufacturers having to have had their products assessed by an approved third-party body such as the BBA, or at least be able to demonstrate that they are in the process of gaining the new approval. The final assessment needs to be in place by 31st December 2024.



HOW DOES IT WORK?

Agrément certification is achieved through a robust series of assessments. This includes demonstrating compliance with the requirements set out in the relevant regulations and standards, through product testing and a factory production control (FPC) audit. The results will then be assessed and, if successful, the manufacturer will receive certification under the Agrément scheme. This means the manufacturer of the product can use the official BBA Agrément logo in their marketing and sales collateral to demonstrate their compliance.

In the case of roof cassettes, certification will enable specification within the new build domestic sector.
